Re. Home Learning Arrangements following the Easter Holiday – Google Classroom

Dear Parent/Carer

We sincerely hope all is going well. We know you will be juggling working from home, along with childcare and teaching your children: this is not an easy task and we appreciate everything you have been doing.

The team have been working hard over the past few weeks setting up a virtual platform which will enable us to teach the children remotely. From Monday April 20th your child will have access to Google Classroom. Once they have accepted their invite into the classroom, they will have daily input from their Teachers and Teaching assistants.

Each day there will be: a greeting from your Teacher; a suggested timetable for the day; Maths and English input with a follow up assignment. There will be a further activity, which is intended to be more creative/cross curricular, but will reflect the year group's summer term themes. Please see class overviews available on the school website.

Assuming staff are well enough, Teachers will be available on class emails between 9am and 12pm each school day. They will be able to respond to any questions children may have or give feedback on work set. Our intention is to deliver everything new in small steps so that the children can be as independent as possible. We are all still learning how to do this, so please bear with us in the early days.

What you need to do now:

Go to googleclassroom.com

It will ask for an email and password

Log in using your child's LGFL emails. It looks something like this: blogs222.313@worple.hounslow.sch.uk

Then enter your child's password for this account

Agree to Terms and Conditions

Enter classroom

Choose [I am a student](#)

Accept the invite to your classroom

If you do not have your child's LGFL email you can contact class Teacher's on year group email eg. year6@worple.hounslow.sch.uk, they have all the children's emails and passwords.

Once you are in the classroom select classwork. There will be a daily greeting from the Teacher who will explain what the day will hold.

Each task will come with instructions from the Teacher, please read these carefully before doing the activity.

If you have any questions about any of the above, or are having trouble logging in, please contact us using the year group email and we will endeavour to iron things out as quickly as possible. We are aware that not all of our families have access to the internet or a computer. Separate arrangements are being made for these families.
