## Year 6 Parents – Secondary School Transfer

If your child is currently in Year 6 and born between 1 September 2007 and 31 August 2008, you will need to apply for a secondary school place by 31 October 2018.

To apply for a secondary school place you will need to use the eAdmissions website. You can name up to six schools in your application including academy or free schools and schools in other council areas. If you do not live in the borough, you need to apply through your own council and you can include schools from other boroughs in your application.

The closing date for applying for a Year 7 place is **31 October 2018**.
