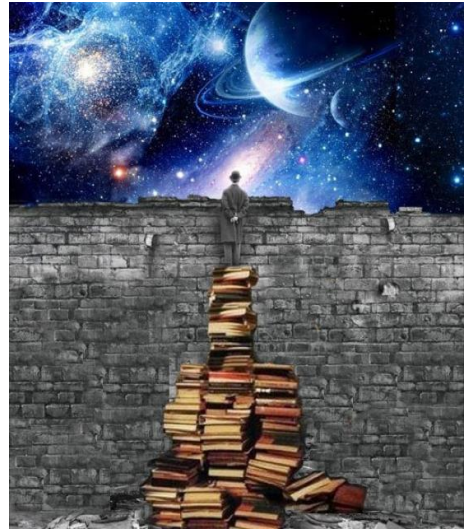
Library News
