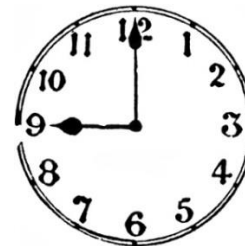
Nursery	Naya – For such great language in our spelling game. Adrian – For trying so hard in his mark-making.
