Year 6 visit to the Imperial war Museum

On Tuesday the Year 6 children visited the Imperial War Museum as part of their work around World War 2.

"We went on the train to the museum and in the entrance we saw a famous tank that was transported to different countries during WW2, an RAF plane (we think it was a spitfire) and a fighter jet. The one thing that interested some of us was that the soldiers in WW1 had to sleep in the rocky trenches until the war ended. We saw a bed sheet that a prisoner of war had embroidered the information of what was happening to her in wool (she hid the bed sheet underneath her bed for 3 years). We got to experience what an Anderson shelter would have felt like, we squeezed inside, was cramped and very warm. We saw an enigma machine that translated code and had many black and white buttons. We had a lot of fun and we would love to go back there again."
