Secondary School Offer Day

Today is national Secondary School offer day for all Year 6 children. If you applied online and on time, you'll be sent an email today telling you your child's school place offer. Please wait until you have received the email before logging onto the eAdmissions website. Emails will be staggered from 5pm onward, so precise timings cannot be guaranteed.

If you have been offered your first preference school, you will only receive the email notification. If you have not been offered your first preference school, you will receive the email notification and a letter, sent by first class post on 1st March, giving you more information about the process and what to do next.

You will need to accept your offer by **15 March 2019** by logging into your eAdmissions account and selecting 'view outcome and respond.' After this date, the online portal will close and you will not be able to accept your offer online.

Times Table Rock Stars!

After a successful trial of the online programme Times Table Rock Stars in Years 5 and 6 we have decided to roll the programme out to all of junior children (Years 3-6). The online programme is designed to help children become more fluent and confident with their times tables. 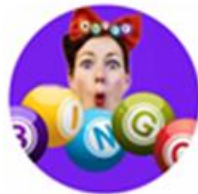
