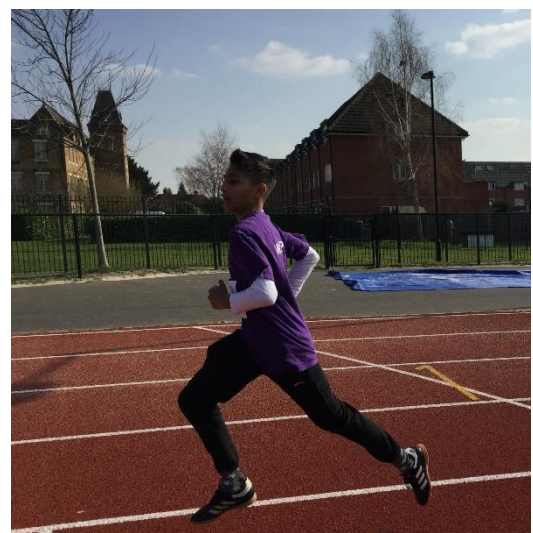
Worple's Art Exhibition
