It has been a quieter week without year 6 being in school, but I am delighted to say that they are all having a totally amazing time, and certainly sounds like they are not missing school!!!!


A huge thank you to the team of staff who have been looking after them all in the Cotswold's this week, I am sure there will be lots of tired eyes when the coach returns on Friday!!!


