

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Independently put our coats on and hang them on our pegs.

Identifying what foods that are healthy and not healthy.

Encourage the children to be more independent when using the toilet.

Encourage children to access group playing activities, such as role play area and construction area.

### Phonics

#### Letters and Sounds:

Phase 1: Rhyming - This will be taught through books, games and songs.

Phase 2: Looking at and learning some of the phase 2 sounds.

These will be taught by saying the sound, learning the action and writing down the letter.

### Communication and Language

Children to take part in listening, singing and rhyming activities.

Encourage children to talk about pictures they have brought in from home to their peers.

Children to ask questions about books we are reading or activities they are involved in.
