



## Sports Premium Spending 2018-19

Worple Primary Sports Premium funding for 2018-19 is **£17,730**. Worple Primary has a contract with Sport Impact <http://www.sportimpact.co.uk/> to help meet these objectives. Sports Impact has been allocated **£8,040** of our Sports Premium for **2018-19**.

### Sports Impact Initiatives

The Sports Premium for 2018-19 has been used for the following OBJECTIVES:

1. Engaging all pupils in regular physical activity – kick starting healthy active lifestyles (Play & Engage, Change4Life, Five a day, walk to school...)
2. Raising the profile of P.E. and sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement (strategic development, leaders...)
3. Increasing confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching P.E. and sport (lesson support/mentoring, inset CPD)
4. Offering a broader experience of a range of sports and activities to all pupils (clubs wide variety of curriculum activities; swimming taster)
5. Increasing participation in competitive sports (Intra & Inter)

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
