**Core texts** – Stig of the dump by Clive King, The Iron Man by Michael Foreman, Seal Surfer by Michael Foreman and Winter's Child by Angela McAllister

## Science

**Animals including humans**

**We will be research and investigating:**

the importance of nutrition for humans and other animal, the role of a skeleton and muscles and how to identify animals with different types of skeleton.

## Mathematics

**Place value** – To represent numbers to 1000, find 1, 10 and 100 more or less than a given number, compare objects and numbers to 1000, count in 50's.

**Addition and Subtraction** – To add and subtract multiples of 100, add and subtract two 3-digit numbers, estimate answers to calculations, spotting patterns and solve problems with missing numbers.

**Multiplication and Division** – To understand multiplication as equal groups, multiplying and dividing by 3,4 and 8, solve problems involving missing numbers.
