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Homework

- ▶ We will be using **Google Classroom** as the platform to set most homework
- ▶ Some homework will need to be submitted online whilst some might need to be completed in your child's purple homework book
- ▶ Weekly Maths and English homework linked with what the children have been learning in class given out on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday
- ▶ Daily reading (When will books be changed?). Your child's books will only be changed if they have read, please ensure that an adult has signed the white reading record book (EYFS, Year 1, 2 and 3)
- ▶ Library books – Your child's library day is on Friday. Children have the opportunity to change their library book at least once a week. These books are intended to be shared with their family.
- ▶ Spellings – Test on Mondays and new words given out on Tuesdays. Children from Year 3 – 6 will be expected to write sentences using the spellings words as part of their homework. Year 2 from the summer term
- ▶ Weekly multiplication table test – this will also include division facts
