Year 4 will start weekly swimming lessons this year, starting from Wednesday 31st October due to refurbishments at Isleworth leisure centre.

The swimming taster sessions will run for 5-6 weeks per class. **Year 5** will be the start their sessions on Thursday 1st November for 6 weeks, followed by Year 3 in Spring 1, Year 2 in Spring 2, Year 1 in Summer 1 and Reception in Summer 2.
