- Although every child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 is entitled to a **free school meal** at lunch time, for the school to receive extra funding parents need to complete the above **form**.
- **Free school meals** are also available to all full-time pupils who are in school and who meet the qualifying criteria.

- Hounslow will check all the details and you never know, you might have gained the school an extra amount of funding.
